- ▶ Our college has adopted 5 villages according to UBA(Unnat Bharat Abayan) welfare scheme from central government which is closely related with EPICS. We are taking forward both the programs in coordination for better approach
- ▶ We have some problem statements identified some problems we our UBA team members have visited the adopted villages and the community partners are invited to the college for interaction.

- ▶ we identified active faculty members in each department
- ▶ In June-2018 when the students came back from the vacation we identified 30 students from different departments and was given an introduction to EPICS.
