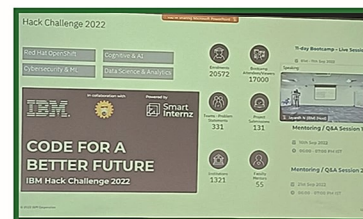
## Niyukta Acharya Award

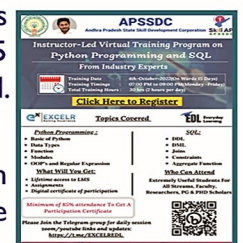


## Training Program

## Bharat Education Excellence Award

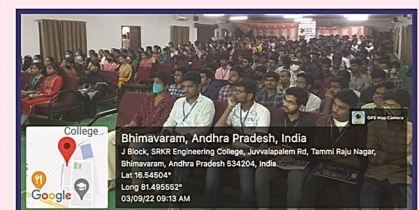

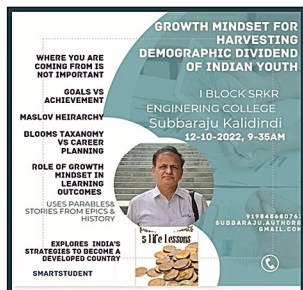


## WEBINAR

## The Tale of the Mockingbird

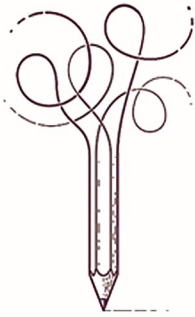

Lonely as it can be.*

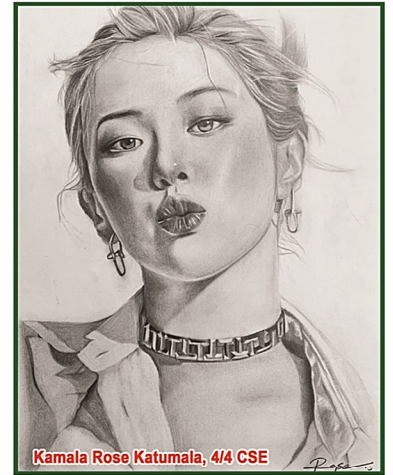
